- Academics: The New Session 2018-19 began on 2nd April, 2018.
- Total Strength of the school: 466
- <u>PTMs and counselling session Held:</u> 1st on completion of UT-1, counselling session was held for all the Board Classes and Kindergarten Section.
- <u>Undertaking:</u> An undertaking from the parents of non-performing students was taken.

Exams:

- 1. UT 1 was conducted successfully with a very positive feedback from the parents on the first PTM.

New implementations for Academic Improvement done:

- 1. Two sections created for class 5th (with strength of 22 each) and 10th (with strength of 28 each) .
- 2. Lesson plan Registers for each subject are maintained by all the teachers.
- 3. Daily diary for each class is being maintained
- 4. Purchase of Photo copier Machine for school to make examination cell self sufficient without any outsourcing of work was achieved.
- 5. Introduction of language club activity and competitions like debates, elocutions, Spell bee etc for enhancing language skills introduced.
- 6. Regular worksheet based and surprise tests for evaluation are being done.
- 7. Word of the day introduced and students for vocabulary skill enhancement and students are evaluated on the same.
- 8. For Uniformity, subject wise colour coded notebook covers were introduced.
